
SIGNAL on the Macintosh!!

SIGNAL can be run from the Macintosh desktop!

SIGNAL can be run on a Macintosh computer using one of several available PC emulator programs. These programs run the Windows operating system in a window on the Macintosh desktop. All SIGNAL computational, display, and programming capabilities are supported on the Macintosh, and basic sound functions are supported by the built-in Macintosh sound chip. Two current products are Parallels and VMware Fusion. Check with the vendors for Macintosh hardware requirements.
